PARTS BULLETIN

This bulletin is being released as a reminder that fabricated parts are shelved with a primer coat only (and in some cases bare metal). In the production of our machines these parts are not painted until after the assembly of a sub section (boom, debris tank, power deck, etc.). When ordering fabricated parts, you must specify if you want the part painted. There is an additional charge for painting to cover labor and materials. Bear in mind that the acrylic urethane paint we use depending on grade and color can cost anywhere from \$125.00 to upwards of \$300.00 a gallon.

If you require a part to be painted, we will need to know the color code of the paint. Color codes can be found on the Unit ID sheet in the owners manual. If this information is unavailable, call our customer service department with the model and serial number and we will look it up for you. Please note that this information may not be available on pre-Hi-Vac built units. For your convenience our more common colors are listed below.

We also would like to remind everyone that we cannot ship hazardous materials (which includes paint) via United Parcel Service (UPS). If you need a small quantity of paint to touch up one of our units, your best course of action is to go to a local automotive paint supplier with the color code information.
